

Engage Members to Participate in Initiatives at the National Level:

Create opportunities for members to contribute their expertise and insights to shape the future of perioperative nursing in Canada by encouraging members to become involved in the review of the standards, nominating candidates for awards, submitting abstracts to the journal and to present at the biennale conference.
